- Your funding proposal must cover all the pillars listed below using the **Application Format obtainable in your DSD District Offices or our website @ www.dsd.limpopo.gov.za**
- Remember to attach all the supportive documents in line with the qualifying criteria requirement.

Pillar 1- Providing Feeding to CNDC beneficiaries through cooked nutritious meals	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Entities must be registered (certificate) and compliant in terms of the Non-Profit Organization Act No 71 of 1997
Pillar 2- Providing COVID-19 food relief in the form of food parcels to food insecure households	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ The organization must have an approved and signed constitution that aligns to respective legal framework.
Pillar 3- Providing food relief to victims of natural and man-made local disasters	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Proof of land/site ownership , Permission to occupy or lease agreement
Pillar 4 - Providing material support such as school uniform, blankets, sanitary towels , baby pampers and any other relevant support to beneficiaries of social relief of distress (SRD)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Funding Proposals are to be submitted on or before stipulated closing Date, Time and Place.▪ Only signed and dated funding Proposals and application letters will be accepted
Pillar 5- Coordinate donation and distribution of food and material support to deserving beneficiaries	<p>Failure to comply with the above requirements shall lead to Disqualification</p> <p>Other requirement will include;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Entities to have Governance structures (Board or Management Committee)▪ Have Recent Bank Statement not older than three (3) months▪ Audited Financial or annual Reports if previous funded the department▪ Relevant Governance, Risk, Financial and Operational policies
Pillar 6- facilitate developmental initiatives and link beneficiaries with sustainable livelihood opportunities as part of exit strategy	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ NPOs must be registered as Public Benefit Organization (PBO) in terms of section 30 of the income Tax act, in respect of tax exemption certificate and section 18A certificate in relation to donations received


